Incorporating Computer Science Standards into the Content Area

What: Cumberland County Public Schools, in conjunction with the Institute for Teaching Through Technology and Innovative Practices (ITTIP) at Longwood University, has been awarded a grant to provide professional development to assist teachers in grades K-8 for incorporating computer science standards into the content area.

Who: Each Region 8 division can have a team of <u>one</u> teacher from <u>each</u> grade level (K-8), as well as <u>one</u> technology resource teacher.

When: During an 8-week online session this fall, participants will learn how to incorporate computer science standards into their daily lessons. This program also has a Trainer-the-Trainer component; therefore, during a 2-day summer 2021 session, participants will receive professional development related to the modules that they will share with co-workers.

Assignments will be given to complete between sessions (approximately 3 hours of work each week – 1 hr. of webinar and 2 hrs. on assignments).

Incentives:

Teachers will receive **recertification points** for participation in the Fall online professional development (30 points recommended), two days PD in Summer 2021 (15 points recommended), and for conducting training sessions for their co-workers during the 2021-22 school year (15 points recommended). In addition to recertification points, teachers will receive a \$300 stipend upon completion of the Fall online session, and an additional \$200 stipend for the two days in Summer 2021.
