

## Global Education Mindset (GEM)

### ENGAGE YOUR STUDENTS

Are you interested in providing your students educational experiences that **reach beyond the classroom** and county lines without breaking the budget? Join ITTIP for an **8-week blended learning book study** to learn how fostering a **growth mindset** and **connecting your students** with learning and resources outside of the classroom can promote important skills (i.e. **Virginia's 5Cs** - communication, collaboration, citizenship, critical thinking, creativity) and **engage and empower your classroom**. During this professional development experience, participating teachers will read and reflect on two books in both asynchronous and synchronous settings and learn how to use technology already in the classroom to create deeper learning experiences for students. Your estimated time commitments are the two face-to-face Saturday sessions and about 4 hours of time associated with each of the five modules (readings, discussions, assignments).

#### Your Responsibilities:

- **Attend 2 Days Face-to-Face Professional Development at Longwood University**
  - Saturday, March 16, 2019 and Saturday, May 11, 2019
  - 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. each day
  - Mileage paid
  - Lunch provided each day
- **Complete Five Online Course Modules**
  - Between March 16 and May 11, complete modules and corresponding assignments, discussions, etc. according to posted due dates
- You will need a reliable internet connection outside of school work hours to access and complete online components

In addition to learning new strategies to engage your students through Global Collaboration, additional benefits include:

- Support from ITTIP staff as needed as you try to implement new strategies
- 30 recertification points
- Books for book study
- Classroom web camera and microphone (to keep) to facilitate online collaborations in the classroom now and in the future
- \$600 stipend (paid after May 11 and completion of all assignments)
