

Incorporating Computer Science Standards into the Content Area

Region 8 Professional Learning Opportunity

What: *Cumberland County Public Schools*, in conjunction with the *Institute for Teaching Through Technology and Innovative Practices (ITTIP)* at Longwood University, has been awarded a grant to provide professional development to assist teachers in grades K-8 for incorporating computer science standards into the content area.

Who: Each Region 8 division can have a team of one teacher from each grade level (K-8), as well as one technology resource teacher.

When: During an **8-week online session this fall**, participants will learn how to incorporate computer science standards into their daily lessons. This program also has a Trainer-the-Trainer component; therefore, during a **2-day summer 2021 session**, participants will receive professional development related to the modules that they will share with co-workers.

Fall Schedule: Teachers will meet online via Zoom for an hour on the following dates & times.

Assignments will be given to complete between sessions (approximately 3 hours of work each week – 1 hr. of webinar and 2 hrs. on assignments).

Incentives: Teachers will receive **recertification points** for participation in the Fall online professional development (30 points recommended), two days PD in Summer 2021 (15 points recommended), and for conducting training sessions for their co-workers during the 2021-22 school year (15 points recommended). In addition to recertification points, teachers will receive a **\$300** stipend upon completion of the Fall online session, and an additional **\$200** stipend for the two days in Summer 2021.
